Clinical activities for 36 years have been in the full time practice of gastroenterology, 32 years in Berkeley, California. I have subspecialized in the care of patients with Inflammatory Bowel Disease.

Since July, 2006, I retired from private practice to join the faculty at UCSF at Mt. Zion, working mainly in The Center for Crohn's and Colitis. My responsibilities involved patient care with the added responsibilities for teaching medical students, residents and GI fellows. I have established an IBD program at SFGH to help care for patients with IBD and teach residents and GI fellows about all facets of IBD. I am also doing this at the VA Hospital. My clinical activities since July, 2008 have centered at SFGH where I continue to run the IBD clinic and attend in the general GI outpatient clinic on a weekly basis.
